



**Junior Investigator Travel Awards for the XIXth International Symposium on Amyloidosis  
May 26-30, 2024  
Rochester, MN**

**Description:** This award is intended to assist young investigators with defraying expenses for travel to the symposium. The awards can be used to cover costs for registration, travel, lodging and meals. The award will be up to \$3000 US.

**Eligibility:** Pre or postdoctoral trainees, fellows or residents that are authors on an abstract accepted for presentation are eligible. Preference will be given to first authors. **Only abstracts accepted by the symposium committee will be reviewed for this award.**

**Application Instructions:** Applications are to be made electronically to the following address – [info@amyloidosis.org](mailto:info@amyloidosis.org) and are due no later than March 1, 2024.

Please include the following information in the application package.

1. A letter that includes the following information
  - a. Name
  - b. Title and affiliation
  - c. Research Mentor
  - d. Current mailing address (including email address)
  - e. Phone Number
2. CV including education, fellowships, employment history and past awards
3. A copy of the abstract submitted to the symposium committee
4. Projected total costs (it is highly recommended that refundable airfare be obtained)
  - a. Registration
  - b. Flight/Train/Shuttle
  - c. Meals (breakfast and dinner – lunch provided by symposium)
  - d. Hotel

**Award Process:** Upon confirmation from the symposium committee that an abstract has been accepted, the AF's Scientific Advisory Board will review the eligible abstracts and advise the Board of their recommendations. Successful candidates will be notified by March 15, 2024.
