## **2023 Research Grant Instructions**

The Amyloidosis Foundation grant program supports basic biomedical and clinical research on systemic amyloidosis.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants who are within 10 years of completion of post-doctoral studies or clinical fellowship are eligible to apply for funding.

Applicants must have a mentor, who guarantees an environment that will support the research project of the applicant.

Applications from scientists in the pharmaceutical industry will not be accepted.

### **Application Instructions**

The Research Grant Application has been developed to allow for electronic submission. The application is in Microsoft Word Format. Single spacing should be used and Ariel 11 pt is the preferred font and size. Applicants are expected to effectively convey the research projects hypothesis, background and proposed methods and results within 5 pages. Within the document there are form fields where the information is to be typed. Any additional information requested on a separate sheet of paper should be submitted as PDF files along with this application.

## **Submission Deadline/Confirmation**

Complete applications must be received by September 13, 2022. You will receive a confirmation email or fax from the AF upon receipt of your application.

## **Selection and Considerations**

The selection of the recipient(s) will be made by the Board of Directors of the Foundation, after all applications have been reviewed by the Scientific Advisory Board, consisting of experts in the field of amyloidosis. Candidates are strictly prohibited from contacting any members of the advisory board regarding status of their application.

The committee will consider most favorably those proposals that provide evidence of an applicant's research initiative and creativity. The committee will also consider the feasibility of meaningful results from the proposed research, and the likely contribution to the advancement of knowledge of Amyloidosis etiology, diagnosis, treatment, or prevention.

## **Selection Notification**

All candidates will receive notification from the Foundation office of the final selection of the recipient(s) via email or mail. The award announcement for this grant cycle will be no later than December 1, 2022.

## **Award Conditions and Reporting**

The monetary award of \$50,000 US will be provided to the awardees sponsoring institution in two payments of \$25,000 US for the direct support of the recipients work during the award year, which will begin January 1, 2023. ***Acknowledgement of receipt of the funds and date of receipt is required of the sponsoring institution.***

By July 1, 2023, a brief update report must be submitted to the Foundation. This report is required prior to the release of the remaining funds. At the conclusion of the award year, the recipient is required to submit a brief written summary of the research conducted.

Recipients are expected to acknowledge the Amyloidosis Foundation in any publications or presentations that result from the funded research.
